How brave they were!

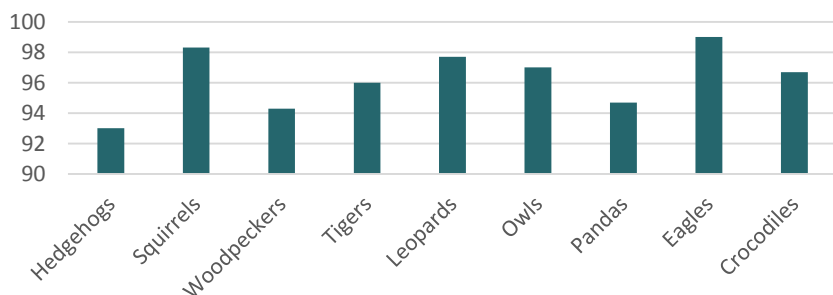
Hatching in the Nursery
