## Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents / Carers,



It was great to see so many children and staff participating in raising money for Red Nose day. This is a worthy charity that we are happy to support. We are still counting, but so far we have raised £275. Thank you and well done!

### Reception Easter Egg Hunts


