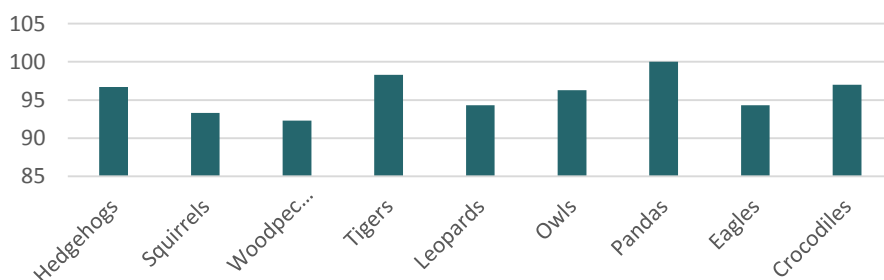
Sports Day – 6th July
