### Year 1—Topic for Next Term

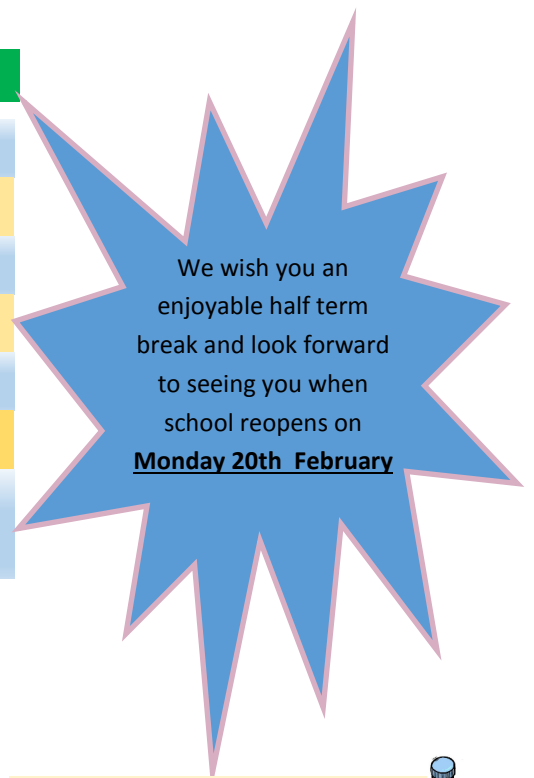
The topic for next term is 'Superheroes'. On Wednesday 22nd February children are invited to come into school dressed as their favourite superhero.

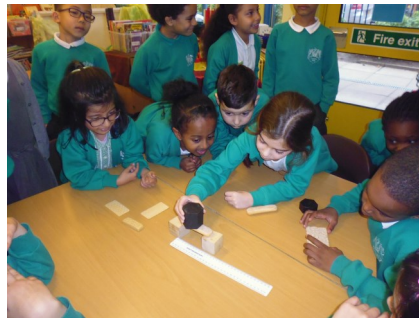

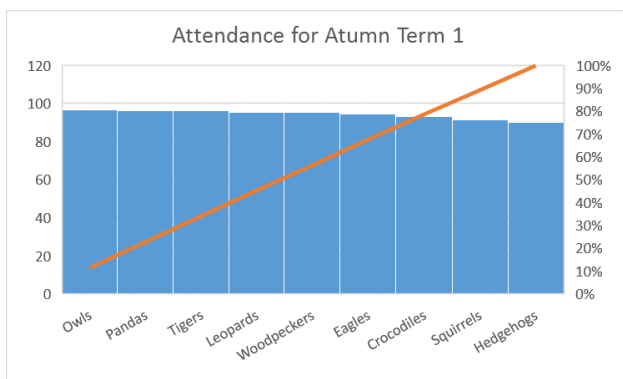
### Medication in school
